Formulas, as well as individual formula elements in Microsoft Equation Editor 3.0; tables, figures and graphs are arranged in the order of mention in the text; drawings are grouped, in black and white. Article file title template: surname of the first author in **Latin_AIIS_2020.doc**.

The following documents must be submitted together with the paper (for participants from Ukraine):
